### **What is required for guest professors?**

As an accredited academic institution, CSBC does have certain required needs for their guest faculty.

1. **Adequate academic credentials.** An earned doctorate for the master's degree courses or a master's degree for the bachelor's degree courses.
2. **Desire and ability to train people for ministry.** More than a job, this must be a calling. CSBS prides themselves in offering a personal touch in their training. Love for students and the ability to train them are vital to the task.
