City: Billings

Title: Fellowship House Intern

Description: The Fellowship House is an incarnational Christian discipleship program working among the poor in Billings. Each intern will be paired with an appropriate ministry/organization that is doing work among the poor in Billings. Such internships can range from working in the schools to working on the streets with homeless people.

The churches' effectiveness in sharing Christ to the elderly community depends on their ability to enable them to be with the church for worship and discipleship. Missionary will have to have a CDL and/or a chauffeur's license. Will need

great people skills and evangelistic passion to coordinate and take the lead in this ministry. Will require as much as twice a day and as many as five out of seven days a week. Sharing Christ with potential riders and focusing on encouragement as they load and unload will be just some of the outreach possibilities of this ministry.
