Significant cost savings, no church account to set up, no set up fees, and the site is ready and available for immediate use. Four levels of background screens are offered that are the most standard for faith based organizations.

Package 1 – Basic \$9.95/Package 2 – Basic with One County Criminal \$21.25/Package 3 – Basic with Multi County Criminal \$36.50/Package 4 – Comprehensive \$38.50 (go to https://faith.clearstar.net for more detailed information on the packages).

Self-pay (credit card entry required) program options:

- 1. Reimburse candidate when background results are received
- 2. Have candidate come to your location to do the background screen and you pay with your credit card upon entry
- 3. Use a re-loadable
 Visa/MasterCard and provide
 card information directly to
 candidate so they can do the
 background screen from their
 home or office.

ClearStar emails candidate when the report is ready to release. They will call ClearStar to confirm their identity and email. When they receive the report from ClearStar, they will forward the report to your email.

All personal information on the report is redacted, so it is safe to email.
