Practice Drill

Blue Cycle

- A caller will call only the King James Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the KJV
- A caller will call only the Christian Standard Bible version of the calls, if all drillers are using the CSB
- A caller will call only the Holman Christian Standard Bible Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the HCSB
- The caller will need to call KJV, CSB, and HCSB calls if all translations are being used in a drill.
- For practice sessions, callers can quickly change up the Book Drill & the Scripture Searching drill on their own to give it variety.
- For additional drills:
 - Steps to Salvation drill include all 6 verses.
 - What We Believe drill would be the other 5 verses not on the Practice Drill.
 - Key Biblical Passages drill would be the other 3 verses not on the Practice Drill.

Attention -Present Bibles -(Give Call) -Start – TIME- (Timekeeper) - Attention

BOOK DRILL- 5 calls

I will call the name of a book. You will locate the book, place your index finger on any verse in that book and step forward. When called upon, you will name the book before, the book called, and the book that follows.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – **AMOS** – Start
(Joel – AMOS – Obadiah)
2. Attention – Present Bibles – **TITUS** – Start
(2 Timothy – TITUS – Philemon)
3. Attention – Present Bibles – **JOB** – Start
(Esther– JOB – Psalms)
4. Attention – Present Bibles – **COLOSSIANS** – Start
(Philippians – COLOSSIANS – 1 Thessalonians)
5. Attention – Present Bibles – **ZECHARIAH** – Start
(Haggai – ZECHARIAH – Malachi)

SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL- 5 Calls

I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When called upon, you will read the verse and give the Scripture reference.

1. Attention-Present Bibles-JAMES 4:17-Start

KJV - "Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin." (James 4:17)

CSB - So it is sin to know the good and yet not do it. (James 4:17)

HCSB '11- So it is a sin for the person who knows to do what is good and doesn't do it. (James 4:17)

2. Attention-Present Bibles-GENESIS 15:6-Start

KJV - "And he believed in the Lord; and he counted it to him for righteousness." (Genesis 15:6)

CSB - Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness. (Genesis 15:6)

HCSB '11- Abram believed the LORD, and He credited it to him as righteousness. (Genesis 15:6)

3. Attention- Present Bibles – JOSHUA 23:11 - Start

KJV— Take good heed therefore unto yourselves, that ye love the Lord your God. (Joshua 23:11)

CSB — So diligently watch yourselves! Love the Lord your God! (Joshua 23:11)

HCSB '11— So be very diligent to love the Lord your God for your own well-being. (Joshua 23:11)

4. Attention-Present Bibles-ROMANS 10:13-Start

KJV - "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." (Romans 10:13)

CSB - For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. (Romans 10:13)

HCSB '11- For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. (Romans 10:13)

5. Attention-Present Bibles-ACTS 4:12-Start

KJV- "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." (Acts 4:12)

CSB - There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12)

HCSB '11- There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people, and we must be saved by it." (Acts 4:12)

STEPS TO SALVATION DRILL – 6 Calls

I will quote a reference of a verse listed in the Steps to Salvation Drill. Each of the references of the six verses will be called out in the order listed on your card. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse before you step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. If called upon, you will recite the entire verse and give the scripture reference. (I will give the KJV first, then CSB, and then HCSB.)

1. Attention – Present Bibles – JOHN 10:10 - Start—Close your Bibles

KJV— The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. **John 10:10**

CSB — A thief comes only to steal and to kill and to destroy. I have come so that they may have life and have it in abundance. **John 10:10**

HCSB '11— A thief comes only to steal and to kill and to destroy. I have come so that they may have life and have it in abundance. **John 10:10**

2. Attention – Present Bibles – ECCLESIASTES 7:20 – Start—Close your Bibles

KJV— For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not. **Ecclesiastes 7:20**

CSB — There is certainly no one righteous on the earth who does good and never sins.
Ecclesiastes 7:20

HCSB '11— There is certainly no righteous man on the earth who does good and never sins.
Ecclesiastes 7:20

3. Attention – Present Bibles – JOHN 14:6 – Start—(Close your Bibles)

KJV— Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. **John 14:6**

CSB — Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” **John 14:6**

HCSB '11— Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.” **John 14:6**

4. Attention – Present Bibles – JOHN 1:12 – Start—(Close your Bibles)

KJV— But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: **John 1:12**

CSB— But to all who did receive him, he gave them the right to be children of God, to those who believe in his name, **John 1:12**

HCSB '11— But to all who did receive Him, He gave them the right to be children of God, to those who believe in His name, **John 1:12**

5. Attention – Present Bibles – **EPHESIANS 2:8-9** – Start—(Close your Bibles)

KJV— For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9**

CSB —For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God’s gift—not from works, so that no one can boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9**

HCSB ’11 — For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God’s gift—not from works, so that no one can boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9**

6. Attention – Present Bibles – **REVELATION 3:20** – Start—(Close your Bibles)

KJV— Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. **Revelation 3:20**

CSB — See! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. **Revelation 3:20**

HCSB ’11— “Listen! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and have dinner with him, and he with Me.” **Revelation 3:20**

WHAT WE BELIEVE DRILL – 5 Calls

I will announce a question from the section of the verse card entitled “What We Believe.” You must correctly locate the verse listed that answers the What We Believe question and place your index finger on the verse before you step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. When called upon, you must be able to recite the question, quote the verse word for word, and state the Scripture reference.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – **WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT THE AUTHORITY OF THE SCRIPTURE?**
– Start—(Close your Bibles)

5. Attention – Present Bibles – **WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT OUR RELATIONSHIP TO GOD?** – Start (Close your Bibles)

KJV— But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: **1 Peter 2:9**

CSB— But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his possession, so that you may proclaim the praises of the one who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. **1 Peter 2:9**

KEY BIBLICAL PASSAGES DRILL – 3 Calls

I will announce a Key Biblical Passage Title taken from this section of verses on your card. Before you step forward, you must correctly locate the passage listed with the Key Biblical Passage on the card. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bible. When called upon, you must be able to give the (1) Key Biblical Passage Title, (2) correctly quote word for word the portion of scripture related to the Key Biblical Passage and (3) recite the correct scripture reference that is associated with that Key Biblical Passage.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – **A PSALM OF PRAISE** – Start (Close your Bibles)

KJV— A PSALM OF PRAISE (Psalm 100) Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands. Serve the Lord with gladness: come before his presence with singing. Know ye that the Lord he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. For the Lord is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations. (Psalm 100)

CSB— A PSALM OF PRAISE (Psalm 100) Let the whole earth shout triumphantly to God! Serve the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. Acknowledge that the LORD is God. He made us, and we are his- his people, the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and bless his name. Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God. Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you. (Matthew 5:3-12)

3. Attention – Present Bibles – **A CHRISTIANS ARMOR** – Start (Close your Bibles)

KJV-- A CHRISTIANS ARMOR (Ephesians 6:13-18) Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; (Ephesians 6:13-18)

CSB— A CHRISTIANS ARMOR (Ephesians 6:13-18) For this reason take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having prepared everything, to take your stand. Stand, therefore, with truth like a belt around your waist, righteousness like armor on your chest, and your feet sandaled with readiness for the gospel of peace. In every situation take up the shield of faith which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit – which is the word of God. Pray at all times in the Spirit with every prayer and request, and stay alert with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints. (Ephesians 6:13-18)

HCSB '11— A CHRISTIANS ARMOR (Ephesians 6:13-18) This is why you must take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having prepared everything, to take your stand.
