Practice Drill

Blue Cycle

- A caller will call only the King James Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the KJV
- A caller will call only the Christian Standard Bible version of the calls, if all drillers are using the CSB
- A caller will call only the Holman Christian Standard Bible Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the HCSB
- The caller will need to call KJV, CSB, and HCSB calls if all translations are being used in a drill.
- For practice sessions, callers can quickly change up the Book Drill & the Scripture Searching drill on their own to give it variety.
- For additional drills:
 - Identifying Versed Drill* would be the other 5 verses not on the Practice Drill.
 - Doctrinal Drill* would be the other 5 verses not on the Practice Drill.
 - Bible Answers Drill* would be the other 5 verses not on the Practice Drill.

Attention -Present Bibles -(Give Call) -Start – TIME- (Timekeeper) - Attention

BOOK DRILL- 5 calls

I will call the name of a book. You will locate the book, place your index finger on any verse in that book and step forward. When called upon, you will name the book before, the book called, and the book that follows.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – **RUTH** – Start
(Judges – RUTH – 1 Samuel)
 2. Attention – Present Bibles – **JAMES** – Start
(Hebrews – JAMES – 1 Peter)
 3. Attention – Present Bibles – **LUKE** – Start
(Mark – LUKE – John)
 4. Attention – Present Bibles – **ECCLESIASTES** – Start
(Proverbs – ECCLESIASTES – Song of Solomon)
 5. Attention – Present Bibles – **EPHESIANS** – Start
(Galatians – EPHESIANS – Philippians)
- Extra Call: Attention – Present Bibles – **EZRA** – Start
(II Chronicles – EZRA – Nehemiah)

SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL- 5 Calls

I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When called upon, you will read the verse and give the Scripture reference.

1. Attention-Present Bibles-PHILIPPIANS 4:4 -Start

KJV – Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice. (Philippians 4:4)

CSB - Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! (Philippians 4:4)

HCSB '11- Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! (Philippians 4:4)

2. Attention-Present Bibles-PSALM 105:43-Start

KJV - And he brought forth his people with joy, *and* his chosen with gladness. (Psalm 105:43)

CSB – He brought his people out with rejoicing, his chosen ones with shouts of joy. (Psalm 105:43)

HCSB '11- He brought His people out with rejoicing, His chosen ones with shouts of joy. (Psalm 105:43)

3. Attention- Present Bibles – JAMES 4:10 - Start

KJV— Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. (James 4:10)

CSB — Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you. (James 4:10)

HCSB '11— Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will exalt you. (James 4:10)

4. Attention-Present Bibles-JEREMIAH 29:13-Start

KJV – And ye shall seek me, and find *me*, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.
(Jeremiah 29:13)

CSB - You will seek me and find me when you search for me with all your heart. (Jeremiah 29:13)

HCSB '11- You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart. (Jeremiah 29:13)

5. Attention-Present Bibles-MATTHEW 4:19-Start

KJV-- And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. (Matthew 4:19)

CSB -- “Follow me,” he told them, “and I will make you fish for people.” (Matthew 4:19)

HCSB '11- “Follow Me,” He told them, “and I will make you fish for people!” (Matthew 4:19)

EXTRA CALL: Attention-Present Bibles-1John 1:8-Start

KJV-- If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (1John 1:8)

CSB – If we say, “We have no sin,” we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (1John 1:8)

HCSB '11- If we say, “We have no sin,” we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (1John 1:8)

IDENTIFYING VERSES DRILL – 5 Calls

I will quote the underlined part of the Scripture verse. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse, and step forward. When called upon, read the entire verse and give the reference.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) - Start—Close your Bibles

KJV— I will praise thee; **for I am fearfully and wonderfully made:** marvelous are they works; and that my soul knoweth right well. Psalm 139:14

CSB — I will praise you because **I have been remarkably and wondrously made.** Your works are wondrous, and I know this very well. Psalm 139:14

HCSB '11— I will praise You because **I have been remarkably and wonderfully made.** Your works are wonderful, and I know this very well. Psalm 139:14

2. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) - Start—Close your Bibles

KJV— **Beware lest any man spoil you** through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 2:8

CSB — **Be careful that no one takes you captive** through philosophy and empty deceit based on human tradition, based on the elements of the world, rather than Christ. Colossians 2:8

HCSB '11— **Be careful that no one takes you captive** through philosophy and empty deceit based on human tradition, based on the elemental forces of the world, and not based on Christ. Colossians 2:8

3. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) - Start—Close your Bibles

KJV— And he said to *them* all, **if any man will come after me,** let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. Luke 9:23

CSB — Then he said to them all, **“If anyone wants to follow after me,** let him deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow me. Luke 9:23

HCSB '11— Then He said to them all, **“If anyone wants to come with Me,** he must deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow Me. Luke 9:23

4. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) - Start—Close your Bibles

KJV— I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, **which is, and which was, and which is to come,** the Almighty. Revelation 1:8

CSB— “I am the Alpha and the Omega,” says the Lord God, **“the one who is, who was, and who is to come,** the Almighty.” Revelation 1:8

5. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) - Start—Close your Bibles

KJV— And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified. Acts 20:32

CSB — “And now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up and to give you an inheritance among all who are sanctified. Acts 20:32

EXTRA DRILL: Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) - Start—Close your Bibles

KJV— For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth.
Job 19:25

CSB — But I know that my Redeemer lives, and at the end he will stand on the dust. Job 19:25

DOCTRINAL DRILL – 5 Calls

I will give you a doctrinal statement; you will locate the verse that corresponds with that doctrinal subject. Place you index finger on the verse, then step out. When called upon, you will state the doctrine, read the verse, and give the reference.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – **THE CHRISTIAN AND SOCIAL CONCERNS** – Start—(Close your Bibles)

KJV— And now, Israel, what doth the Lord thy God require of thee, but to fear the Lord thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all they soul, Deuteronomy 10:12

3. Attention – Present Bibles – **THE KINGDOM** – Start (Close your Bibles)

4. Attention – Present Bibles – **STEWARDSHIP** – Start (Close your Bibles)

KJV— I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.

BIBLE ANSWERS DRILL – 5 Calls

I will ask a question. You will locate the verse that answers the question, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. When called upon, please quote the question, recite the verse WORD FOR WORD, and state the reference.
