

# Sample Drill Calls

Sample Drills are for **practice only**.  
Church, Associational, and State drills will contain 24 calls.

## **Book Drill**

Our first section will be the “Book Call”. I will give the name of a book in the Bible and you will find the book. Place a finger on any verse in the book named and step forward. If I call your number, you will say the book *before* the one named, the book named and the book that *follows*.

**Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

*Isaiah. (pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Song of Solomon, ISAIAH, Jeremiah

## **Key Passage Drill**

We will now have the “Key Passage Drill”. I will give the title of a key passage. You will find the passage, place a finger on any verse in the passage, and step forward. If called upon, I will ask you to state the key passage title, the reference, and will ask you to read a verse within that passage.

**Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**The Resurrection of Jesus** *(pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** The Resurrection of Jesus / Matthew 28

**Please read verse 2.**

**KJV – Matthew 28:2** “And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it.”

**HCSB – Matthew 28:2** “Suddenly there was a violent earthquake, because an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and approached [the tomb]. He rolled back the stone and was sitting on it.”

**CSB – Matthew 28:2** “There was a violent earthquake, because an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and approached the tomb. He rolled back the stone and was sitting on it.”

## **Quotation Drill**

We will now have the Quotation Drill. You may place your Bibles on the floor behind you OR continue to hold your Bibles. I will give the reference of a verse. If you know the verse, step forward, and when called

upon quote the verse and reference. Please speak slowly and clearly, so that the Judges and I can hear you correctly.

**Attention.**

**Genesis 1:31** *(pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV - “And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.” Genesis 1:31**

**HCSB - “God saw all that He had made, and it was very good. Evening came and then morning: the sixth day.” Genesis 1:31**

**CSB - “God saw all that he had made, and it was very good indeed. Evening came and then morning: the sixth day.” Genesis 1:31**

### **Completion Drill**

**We will now have the Completion Drill. I will give you a portion of a verse of Scripture.**

**If you know the entire verse and where it is found, step forward. When called upon, recite the entire verse and the reference.**

**(Note to Caller: When using more than one version, say: “Some of you are using different versions of the Bible. I will name the version and the portion of the verse for each version represented. If I call on you during the drill for the correct response, you may ask me to repeat the verse again.”)**

**Attention.**

**KJV - “Let no man despise...”** *(pause)*

**HCSB - “Let no one despise...”** *(pause)*

**CSB - “Don’t let anyone despise...”** *(pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV - “Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity” 1 Timothy 4:12**

**HCSB - “Let no one despise your youth; instead, you should be an example to the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.” 1 Timothy 4:12**

**CSB - “Don’t let anyone despise your youth, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity.” 1 Timothy 4:12**
