COOPERATIVE PROGRAM | 2020-21 BUDGET

The Tennessee Baptist Mission Board of Directors acting as the Tennessee Baptist Convention ad interim adopted the 2020-2021 Cooperative Program Budget goal of \$35,000,000, with \$800,000 allocated to Cooperative Program Administration and Promotion and with the remainder allocated as follows, provided that the goal is obtained:

The first \$25 million received for Cooperative Program will be allocated, shifting more funding to TBC causes. This would allocate 40% to the SBC and 60% to the TBC. If giving levels remain consistent with 2020, then this stage should last from November 2020 through June or July of 2021.

Once \$25 million in receipts is received, the next \$5 million in receipts will be allocated between SBC and TBC almost equally.

Finally, anything over \$30 million will be allocated, shifting more funding to SBC causes. This would allocate 81.30% to the SBC and 18.70% to the TBC. This will prove to be a significant increase to SBC.
