



POSITION DESCRIPTION

Title: Middle Tennessee State University BCM Campus Missionary (RESIDENT)

General Classification: Exempt Ministry Position

Supervisor: Mark Whitt, MTSU BCM Campus Minister

Time Required: 40 hours/week+

Principal Function: The Campus Missionary is an entry-level ministry position whereby the Campus Missionary is engaged in the care of souls on a College/University campus and the safe administration of a ministry facility. The Campus Missionary must be an active participant in a Southern Baptist Church.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

1. Periodic Worship leadership
2. Teaching the Bible to ministry participants.
3. Encouraging students to grow as Christian Disciples
4. Provide supervision and reasonable security of the BCM Center.
5. Participate in ministry on-campus and off-campus mission/outreach opportunities
6. Relate to local partnering churches
7. Provide staff leadership to student leadership team
8. Perform other duties as needed or assigned.

Physical Requirements for Individual in Position:

1. Is required to physically reside in the BCM Center/properties
2. May require some lifting/moving of supplies for ministry event set-up
3. Walking campus on a regular basis

Credentials and experience:

1. College Graduate
2. Prior experience of leadership in college ministry

Knowledge and Skills:

1. Ability to lead small groups
2. Willingness and ability to share the Gospel
