Specific items include 1) new towels and linens, 2) 50-100 hygiene bags which would include tissues, toilet paper, deodorant, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, mouthwash, body soap, razors, shaving cream, feminine products, etc., 3) 50-100 buckets of cleaning supplies which would include all purpose cleaner, laundry detergent, dishwashing liquid, paper towels, etc., 4) 50-100 boxes of food which may include canned meats, canned vegetables, dry goods, and more. The center can also use new/gently used clothing and household items, appliances, and furniture. BYBC and Block party locations are within 5 minutes of ministry site. Construction projects are typically located anywhere from 5 to 30 minutes away. Resort ministry available at Roan Mountain State Park campground. Typically includes BYBC for children in the mornings and Family Nights in the evenings, available to everyone in the campground. May include food, games, music, etc. There is a fee to use the campground pavilion, which would need to be reserved in advance and is subject to availability. The campground is located approximately 30 minutes from the ministry center.

Housing and Food Preparation: Group is responsible for housing and food. Housing for a small group is available at no cost at our ministry center which has 3 showers and a small kitchen. Group would need to bring air mattresses. Also, there is an older hotel nearby, as well as cabins and VRBO rentals. Other hotels are available in Johnson City which is approximately 15-20 minutes from our ministry center.
