

Youth Bible Drill 2024 Practice Drill Red Cycle

- A caller will call only the King James Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the KJV
- A caller will call only the Christian Standard Bible version of the calls, if all drillers are using the CSB
- The caller will need to call KJV and CSB calls if all translations are being used in a drill.
- For practice sessions, callers can quickly change up the Book Drill & the Scripture Searching drill on their own to give it variety.

Attention -Present Bibles - (Give Call) -Start - TIME- (Timekeeper) - Attention

BOOK DRILL- 5 calls

I will call the name of a book. You will locate the book, place your index finger on any verse in that book and step forward. When called upon, you will name the book before, the book called, and the book that follows.

1. Attention-Present Bibles-EXODUS-Start

(Genesis- Exodus- Leviticus)

2. Attention-Present Bibles-1 CORINTHIANS-Start

(Romans-1 Corinthians-2 Corinthians)

3. Attention-Present Bibles-PROVERBS-Start

(Psalms-Proverbs-Ecclesiastes)

4. Attention-Present Bibles-MARK-Start

(Matthew-Mark-Luke)

5. Attention-Present Bibles-HEBREWS-Start

(Philemon-Hebrews-James)

Extra: Attention-Present Bibles-JEREMIAH-Start

(Isaiah-Jeremiah-Lamentations)



SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL- 5 Calls

I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When called upon, you will read the verse and give the Scripture reference.

- 1. Attention-Present Bibles-HEBREWS 13:1-Start
 - KJV Let brotherly love continue.
 - CSB Let brotherly love continue.
- 2. Attention-Present Bibles-JOHN 10:2-Start
 - KJV But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep.
 - CSB The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep.
- 3. Attention-Present Bibles-GENESIS 15:6-Start
 - KJV And he believed in the Lord; and he counted it to him for righteousness.
 - CSB Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness.
- 4. Attention-Present Bibles-PHILIPPIANS 2:5-Start
 - KJV Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus.
 - CSB Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus,
- 5. Attention-Present Bibles-JAMES 4:17-Start
 - KJV Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.
 - CSB So it is sin to know the good and yet not do it.
- Extra: Attention-Present Bibles-ROMANS 10:13-Start
 - KJV For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
 - CSB For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.



IDENTIFYING VERSES DRILL - 5 Calls

I will quote the underlined part of the Scripture verse. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse, and step forward. When called upon, read the entire verse and give the reference. (I will give the KJV first, the CSB second and the HCSB last.)

- 1. Attention-Present Bibles-(give portion of the verse underlined)-Start
 - KJV Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, <u>then ye shall be a</u> <u>peculiar treasure</u> unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: Exodus 19:5
 - CSB Now if you will carefully listen to me and keep my covenant, <u>you will be my own</u> <u>possession out of all the peoples</u>, although the whole earth is mine, Exodus 19:5
- 2. Attention-Present Bibles-(give portion of verse underlined)-Start
 - KJV But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the Lord, <u>I will put my law in their inward parts</u>, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people. Jeremiah 31:33
 - CSB "Instead, this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days"—the LORD's declaration. <u>"I will put my teaching within them</u> and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. Jeremiah 31:33
- 3. Attention-Present Bibles- (give portion of verse underlined)-Start
 - KJV <u>Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast</u>, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord. 1 Corinthians 15:58
 - CSB <u>Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, be steadfast</u>, immovable, always excelling in the Lord's work, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain. 1 Corinthians 15:58
- 4. Attention-Present Bibles-(give portion of verse underlined)-Start
 - KJV <u>Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:</u> Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men. Philippians 2:5-7
 - CSB <u>Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus</u>, who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. Philippians 2:5-7a



- 5. Attention-Present Bibles-(give portion of verse underlined)-Start
 - KJV <u>But let us, who are of the day</u>, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Thessalonians 5:8-9
 - CSB <u>But since we belong to the day</u>, let us be self-controlled and put on the armor of faith and love, and a helmet of the hope of salvation. For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, 1 Thessalonians 5:8-9

Extra: Attention-Present Bibles-(give portion of verse underlined)-Start

- KJV <u>Trust in him at all times:</u> ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Selah. Psalm 62:8
- CSB <u>Trust in him at all times</u>, you people; pour out your hearts before him. God is our refuge. Selah Psalm 62:8

DOCTRINAL DRILL – 5 Calls

I will give you a doctrinal statement; you will locate the verse that corresponds with that doctrinal subject. Place your index finger on the verse, then step out. When called upon, you will state the doctrine, read the verse, and give the reference. (You may state these in the order that is most comfortable for you).

- 1. Attention-Present Bibles-EDUCATION-Start
 - KJV Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go. Isaiah 48:17
 - CSB This is what the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel says: I am the LORD your God, who teaches you for your benefit, who leads you in the way you should go. Isaiah 48:17
- 2. Attention-Present Bibles-GOD-Start
 - KJV And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father) full of grace and truth. John 1:14
 - CSB The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed his glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14



3. Attention-Present Bibles-EVANGELISM AND MISSIONS-Start

- KJV And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! Romans 10:15
- CSB- And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news. Romans 10:15

4. Attention-Present Bibles-SCRIPTURE-Start

- KJV Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. 2 Peter 1:20-21
- CSB Above all, you know this: No prophecy of Scripture comes from the prophet's own interpretation, because no prophecy ever came by the will of man; instead, men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. 2 Peter 1:20-21

5. Attention-Present Bibles-THE CHURCH-Start

- KJV Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee. Hebrews 2:12
- CSB saying: I will proclaim your name to my brothers and sisters; I will sing hymns to you in the congregation. Hebrews 2:12

Extra: Attention-Present Bibles-**THE LORD'S DAY**-Start

- KJV Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Exodus 20:8
- CSB Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy: Exodus 20:8



BIBLE ANSWERS DRILL – 5 Calls

I will ask a question. You will locate the verse that answers the question, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. When called upon, please quote the question, recite the verse WORD FOR WORD, and state the reference.

- 1. Attention-Present Bibles-WHO SHOULD I TRUST?-Start-(Close your Bibles)
 - KJV Trust ye in the Lord for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength. Isaiah 26:4
 - CSB Trust in the LORD forever, because in the LORD, the LORD himself, is an everlasting rock! Isaiah 26:4
- 2. Attention-Present Bibles-WHAT DOES JESUS REQUIRE OF ME?-Start-(Close your Bibles)
 - KJV Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. Matthew 16:24
 - CSB Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone wants to follow after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me. Matthew 16:24
- 3. Attention-Present Bibles-WHO LIVES IN ME?-Start-(Close your Bibles)
 - KJV I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20
 - CSB I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20
- 4. Attention-Present Bibles-HOW CAN I RESIST THE DEVIL?-Start-(Close your Bibles)
 - KJV Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7
 - CSB Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7
- 5. Attention-Present Bibles-WHO IS JESUS?-Start-(Close your Bibles)
 - KJV Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God. 1 John 4:15
 - CSB Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God—God remains in him and he in God. 1 John 4:15



- Extra: Attention-Present Bibles-AM I ALONE? Start-(Close your Bibles)
 - KJV Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest. Joshua 1:9
 - CSB Haven't I commanded you: be strong and courageous? Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9
