## If My Church Wants to Start a Church, How Do We Do That?

### HERE ARE A FEW METHODS



**PARACHUTE:** A planter and their family move into a new location to start a church from scratch. There is no team.



**HOUSE CHURCH/ORGANIC CHURCH:** Small groups form and multiply via a network of people meeting in homes. We call these in Tennessee **1-5-1 Churches**.



**MISSIONARY TEAM:** A team of people from the mother church go out into the community, share the gospel, and make disciples.



**SATELLITE/CAMPUS/MULTI-SITE:** An existing church opens new locations. The idea is for one church to have other meeting locations.



**RESTART/RE-LAUNCH:** An existing struggling church decides to bury the old and plant a fresh new church.



**CHURCH WITHIN A CHURCH:** Allowing your church facility to be used by either an ethnic group or an affinity group that is not being reached.

These are just a few methods that your church can use to start a new congregation. There are even some hybrids of the ways listed above.



The key thing for your church is having a burden to see an unreached community or people group be reached with the Gospel and develop them to become disciples for Jesus.
