# Practice Bible Drill One

Welcome to \_\_\_\_\_ (Church) Bible Drill. My name is \_\_\_\_\_. I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these children have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart.

Thank you, parents and church leaders, for encouraging and supporting your children. We know today is a special day for them and your family. Let me remind you that during the drill you may not be able to hear everything I say because my back will be to you. The children will be asked to keep their eyes on me. They may glance at you so be sure to keep a smile on your face to encourage them.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions by turning off cell phones, electronic games, and other devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

## ***Turn towards the Children.***

Girls and boys, now I want to remind you:

- Keep your hands at your side until I say "attention."
- Your eyes are to stay on me until I say "start."
- Do not step out if you don't know the answer.
- Place your index finger on your Bible **before** stepping out.
- If you start forward when "time" is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you "beat the clock."
- If you step forward, don't go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand. When I acknowledge your hand, you may lower it but do not step back.
- Treat your Bible with respect.

One last thing: Remember if you make a mistake while answering I will give you an opportunity to correct it. After that, I will call on a 2<sup>nd</sup> child and if an incorrect response is given, then I will give the correct response and move on.

- I. Our first section will be the “Book Call”. I will give the name of a book in the Bible and you will find the book. Place a finger on any verse in the book named and step forward. If I call your number, you will say the book *before* the one named, the book named and the book that *follows*. Our first call will be a practice call.**

*Leviticus. (pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Exodus, LEVITICUS, Numbers

**2. Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

*Jeremiah. (pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Isaiah, JEREMIAH, Lamentations

**3. Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

*1 Kings (pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** 2 Samuel, 1 KINGS, 2 Kings

*John. (pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Luke, JOHN, Acts

**Ruth.** *(pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Judges, RUTH, 1 Samuel

**Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**Ephesians.** *(pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Galatians, EPHESIANS, Philippians

**II. We will now have the “Key Passage Drill”. I will give the title of a key passage. You will find the passage, place a finger on any verse in the passage, and step forward. If called upon, I will ask you to state the key passage title, the reference, and will ask you to read a verse within that passage. Our first call will be a practice call.**

### Practice Call:

**Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**A Shepherd’s Song** *(pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER: A Shepherd’s Song / Psalm 23**

**Please read verse 2.**

**KJV – He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. Psalm 23:2**

**CSB – He lets me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside quiet waters. Psalm 23:2**

**Judges and children, we will now begin the Key Passage Drill.**

**1. Attention**

**Present Bibles.**

**The Suffering Servant** (*pause*)

**Start.** (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

**ANSWER: The Suffering Servant / Isaiah 53**

**Please read verse 6.**

**KJV – All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6**

**CSB – We all went astray like sheep; we all have turned to our own way; and the LORD has punished him for the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6**

**2. Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**The Work of the Holy Spirit** (*pause*)

**Start.** (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

**ANSWER: The Work of the Holy Spirit / John 16:5-15**

**Please read verse 12.**

**KJV – I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. John 16:12**

**CSB – “I still have many things to tell you, but you can't bear them now. John 16:12**

**3. Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**God's Covenant with Abraham** (*pause*)

**Start.** (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

**ANSWER: God's Covenant with Abraham / Genesis 12:1-3**

**Please read verse 2. PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN KJV**

**KJV – And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing. Genesis 12:2**

**CSB – I will make you into a great nation, I will bless you, I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. Genesis 12:2**

**Continues>>>>**

4. Attention

Present Bibles.

The Resurrection of Jesus *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Resurrection of Jesus / Matthew 28

Please read verse 18.

KJV – And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Matthew 28:18

CSB – Jesus came near and said to them, “All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. Matthew 28:18

5. Attention

Present Bibles.

The Conversion of Saul *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Conversion of Saul / Acts 9:1-30

Please read verse 22. PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN CSB

KJV - But Saul increased the more in strength, and confounded the Jews which dwelt at Damascus, proving that this is very Christ. Acts 9:22

CSB - But Saul grew stronger and kept confounding the Jews who lived in Damascus by proving that Jesus is the Messiah. Acts 9:22

6. Attention:

Present Bibles.

The Love Chapter *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Love Chapter/ 1 Corinthians 13

Please read verse 13. PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN KJV

KJV - And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. 1 Corinthians 13:13

CSB - Now these three remain: faith, hope, and love – but the greatest of these is love. 1 Corinthians 13:13

**Optional Key Passage Calls**

**Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**The Twelve Apostles** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER: The Twelve Apostles / Matthew 10:2-4**

**Please read verse 4.**

**KJV – Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him. Matthew 10:4**

**CSB – Simon the Zealot, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him. Matthew 10:4**

**Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**Jesus’ First Miracle** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER: Jesus First Miracle / John 2:1-11**

**Please read verse 5.**

**KJV – His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.  
John 2:5**

**CSB – “Do whatever he tells you,” his mother told the servants. John 2:5**

**Continues>>>>**

**III. We will now have the Quotation Drill. You may place your Bibles on the floor behind you OR continue to hold your Bibles. I will give the reference of a verse. If you know the verse, step forward, and when called upon (*step forward, remove your mask and*) quote the verse and reference. Please speak slowly and clearly, so that the Judges and I can hear you correctly. We will begin with a practice call.**

**Practice Call:**

**Attention.**

**Luke 2:52** (*pause*)

**Start.** (*Call on child after "time" has been called.*)

ANSWER:

**KJV – And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man. Luke 2:52**

**CSB - And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and with people.  
Luke 2:52**

**Judges and children, we now begin the Quotation Drill.**

**1. Attention.**

**Isaiah 45:5** (*pause*)

**Start.** (*Call on child after "time" has been called.*)

ANSWER:

**KJV – I am the LORD, and *there is* none else, *there is* no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me: Isaiah 45:5**

**CSB – I am the LORD, and there is no other; there is no God but me. I will strengthen you, though you do not know me, Isaiah 45:5**

**2. Attention**

**James 1:22** (*pause*)

**Start.** (*Call on child after "time" has been called.*)

ANSWER:

**KJV – But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. James 1:22**

**CSB – But be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. James 1:22**

**Continues>>>>**



**3. Attention**

**Romans 10:9** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. Romans 10:9**

**CSB – If you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9**

**4. Attention**

**Luke 19:10** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost. Luke 19:10**

**CSB – For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save the lost.” Luke 19:10**

**5. Attention**

**Psalm 119:11** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. Psalm 119:11**

**CSB – I have treasured your word in my heart so that I may not sin against you. Psalm 119:11**

**6. Attention.**

**John 13:35** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV - By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.  
John 13:35**

**CSB - By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”  
John 13:35**

**Continues>>>>**

**Optional Quotation Calls:**

**Attention.**

**Proverbs 22:1** *(pause)*

**Start.**

*(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV - A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold. Proverbs 22:1**

**CSB - A good name is to be chosen over great wealth; favor is better than silver and gold. Proverbs 22:1**

**IV. We will now have the Completion Drill. I will give you a portion of a verse of Scripture. If you know the entire verse and where it is found, step forward. When called upon, recite the entire verse and the reference. The first call will be a Practice Call.**

**(Note to Caller: When using more than one version, say: “Some of you are using different versions of the Bible. I will name the version and the portion of the verse for each version represented. If I call on you during the drill for the correct response, you may ask me to repeat the verse again.”)**

**Practice Call:**

**Attention.**

**KJV - Also I heard the voice... *(pause)***

**CSB - Then I heard the voice... *(pause)***

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV - Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me. Isaiah 6:8**

**CSB - Then I heard the voice of the Lord asking: Who will I send: Who will go for us? I said: Here I am. Send me. Isaiah 6:8**

## Judges and Children, we will now begin the Completion Drill.

### 1. Attention.

**KJV – Bring ye all the tithes...** *(pause)*

**CSB – Bring the full tenth...** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV –Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that *there shall not be room enough to receive it.*  
Malachi 3:10**

**CSB –Bring the full tenth into the storehouse so that there may be food in my house. Test me in this way,” says the LORD of Armies. “See if I will not open the floodgates of heaven and pour out a blessing for you without measure. Malachi 3:10**

### 2. Attention.

**KJV – God is a Spirit:...** *(pause)*

**CSB – God is spirit,...** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.  
John 4:24**

**CSB – God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and in truth.” John 4:24**

**Continues>>>>**

**3. Attention**

**KJV – Know ye not... (pause)**

**CSB – Don't you yourselves know... (pause)**

**Start.** *(Call on a child after "time" has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and *that* the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?  
1 Corinthians 3:16**

**CSB – Don't you yourselves know that you are God's temple and that the Spirit of God lives  
in you? 1 Corinthians 3:16**

**4. Attention**

**KJV – Study to shew... (pause)**

**CSB - Be diligent to present... (pause)**

**Start.** *(Call on a child after "time" has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed,  
rightly dividing the word of truth. 2 Timothy 2:15**

**CSB – Be diligent to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who doesn't need to be  
ashamed, correctly teaching the word of truth. 2 Timothy 2:15**

**5. Attention**

**KJV – Neither is there salvation in any other:... (pause)**

**CSB – There is salvation in no one else,... (pause)**

**Start.** *(Call on a child after "time" has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given  
among men, whereby we must be saved. Acts 4:12**

**CSB – There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people  
by which we must be saved." Acts 4:12**

**Continues>>>>**

**6. Attention**

**KJV – In every thing give thanks:… (pause)**

**CSB – give thanks in everything;… (pause)**

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.  
1 Thessalonians 5:18**

**CSB – give thanks in everything; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.  
1 Thessalonians 5:18**

**We have now completed the Completion Drill.**

**Optional Completion Drill**

**KJV – Sing unto him, sing psalms… (pause)**

**CSB – Sing to him; sing praise… (pause)**

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV – Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works.  
1 Chronicles 16:9**

**CSB – Sing to him; sing praise to him; tell about all his wondrous works! 1 Chronicles 16:9**

**We are finished! Thank you, boys and girls for doing such a wonderful job. Our judges will now leave to tally the results of our Drill. Parents, at this time it will be fine to take pictures. While our Judges are getting the results together, we will say the Books of the Bible. Number one, will you begin please?**

*(You may use this time in several ways. Testimonies by drillers of what Bible Drill means to them or sharing a fun time their Bible Drill has shared together are some possibilities as you wait for the Judges to return.)*
