Practice Bible Drill – Drill No. 2

Welcome to _____ (church) Bible Drill. My name is _____. I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these children have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart.

Thank you, parents and church leaders, for encouraging and supporting your children. We know today is a special day for them and your family. Let me remind you that during the drill you may not be able to hear everything I say because my back will be to you. The children will be asked to keep their eyes on me. They may glance at you so be sure to keep a smile on your face to encourage them.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions by turning off cell phones, electronic games, and devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, then please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

Turn towards the Children.

Girls and boys, now I want to remind you:

- Keep your hands at your side until I say "attention."
- Your eyes are to stay on me until I say "start."
- Do not step out if you don't know the answer.
- Place your index finger on your Bible **before** stepping out.
- If you start forward when "time" is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you "beat the clock."
- If you step forward, don't go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand.
- If you are called upon, take one step forward and remove your mask to answer. After answering replace your mask and step back. (USE IF WEARING MASKS)
- Treat your Bible with respect.

One last thing: Remember if you make a mistake while answering I will give you an opportunity to correct it. After that, I will call on a 2nd child and if an incorrect response is given, then I will give the correct response and move on.

Are there any questions?

Let's start with a word of prayer. (Pray.)

We will begin each section with a practice call. These do not count for or against you.

- I. **Our first section will be the “Book Call”. I will give the name of a book in the Bible and you will find the book. Place a finger on any verse in the book named and step forward. If I call your number, you will say the book *before* the one named, the book named and the book that *follows*. Our first call will be a practice call.**

Practice Call:

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Joshua, JUDGES, Ruth

Judges and children, we now begin the Book Drill.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Isaiah. (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Song of Solomon, ISAIAH, Jeremiah

2. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Mark. (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Matthew, MARK, Luke

3. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Jonah. (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Obadiah, JONAH, Micah

4. Attention.

Present Bibles.

1 Corinthians. (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Romans, 1 CORINTHIANS, 2 Corinthians

5. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Daniel. (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Ezekiel, DANIEL, Hosea

6. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Hebrews. (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Philemon, HEBREWS, James

This ends the Book Drill.

II. We will now have the “Key Passage Drill”. I will give the title of a key passage. You will find the passage, place a finger on any verse in the passage, and step forward. If called upon, I will ask you to state the key passage title, the reference, and will ask you to read a verse within that passage. Our first call will be a practice call.

Practice Call:

Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Work of the Holy Spirit *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Work of the Holy Spirit / John 16:5-15

Please read verse 6.

KJV – But because I have said these things unto you, sorrow hath filled your heart. John 16:6

CSB – Yet, because I have spoken these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. John 16:6

Judges and children, we now begin the Key Passage Drill.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Jesus’ First Miracle *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Jesus First Miracle / John 2:1-11

Please read verse 7.

KJV – Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim. John 2:7

CSB – “Fill the jars with water,” Jesus told them. So they filled them to the brim. John 2:7

Continue >>>>

2. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Resurrection of Jesus *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Resurrection of Jesus / Matthew 28

Please read verse 6.

**KJV – He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.
Matthew 28:6**

**CSB – He is not here. For he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.
Matthew 28:6**

3. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Suffering Servant *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Suffering Servant / Isaiah 53

Please read verse 4.

**KJV – Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken,
smitten of God, and afflicted. Isaiah 53:4**

**CSB – Yet he himself bore our sicknesses, and he carried our pains; but we in turn regarded him
stricken, struck down by God, and afflicted. Isaiah 53:4**

4. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Parable of the Good Samaritan *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Parable of the Good Samaritan / Luke 10:25-37

Please read verse 31.

**KJV – And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by
on the other side. Luke 10:31**

**CSB – A priest happened to be going down that road. When he saw him, he passed by on the other
side. Luke 10:31**

5. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Conversion of Saul *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Conversion of Saul / Acts 9:1-30

Please read verse 4. PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN CSB

KJV – And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutes thou me? Acts 9:4

CSB – Falling to the ground, he heard a voice saying to him, “Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?” Acts 9:4

6. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Twelve Apostles *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: The Twelve Apostles / Matthew 10:2-4

Please read verse 2.

KJV – Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother; Matthew 10:2

CSB – These are the names of the twelve apostles: First, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother; Matthew 10:2

This ends the Key Passage Drill.

Continue>>>>

Optional Key Passage Calls

Attention.

Present Bibles.

God's Covenant with Abraham (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after "time" has been called.*)

ANSWER: God's Covenant with Abraham / Genesis 12:1-3

Please read verse 1. PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN KJV

KJV– NOW the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: Genesis 12:1

CSB – The LORD said to Abram: Go out from your land, your relatives, and your father's house to the land that I will show you. Genesis 12:1

Attention.

Present Bibles.

A Shepherd's Song (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after "time" has been called.*)

ANSWER: A Shepherd's Song / Psalm 23

Please read verse 2.

KJV – He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. Psalm 23:2

CSB – He lets me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside quiet waters. Psalm 23:2

Continue >>>>

III. We will now have the Quotation Drill. You may place your Bibles on the floor behind you OR continue to hold your Bibles. I will give the reference of a verse. If you know the verse, step forward and when called upon quote the verse and reference. Please speak slowly and clearly, so that the Judges and I can hear you correctly. We will begin with a practice call.

Practice Call:

Attention

Deuteronomy 16:17 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD thy God which he hath given thee. Deuteronomy 16:17

CSB – Everyone must appear with a gift suited to his means, according to the blessing the LORD your God has given you. Deuteronomy 16:17

Judges and children, we now begin the Quotation Drill.

1. Attention.

Luke 2:52 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man. Luke 2:52

CSB - And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and with people. Luke 2:52

2. Attention.

Romans 10:9 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. Romans 10:9

CSB – If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9

Continue >>>>

3. Attention.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

**KJV – In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
1 Thessalonians 5:18**

**CSB – give thanks in everything; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
1 Thessalonians 5:18**

4. Attention.

1 Timothy 4:12 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12

CSB – Don't let anyone despise your youth, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12

5. Attention.

Genesis 1:31 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day. Genesis 1:31

CSB – God saw all that he had made, and it was very good indeed. Evening came and then morning: the sixth day. Genesis 1:31

6. Attention.

Ephesians 2:8 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Ephesians 2:8

CSB – For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God's gift - Ephesians 2:8

Continue >>>>

This ends the Quotation Drill.

Optional Quotation Calls:

Attention.

Psalm 56:3 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee. Psalm 56:3

CSB – When I am afraid, I will trust in you. Psalm 56:3

Attention.

John 4:24 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.
John 4:24

CSB – God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and in truth.
John 4:24

IV. We will now have the Completion Drill. I will give you a portion of a verse of Scripture. If you know the entire verse and where it is found, step forward. When called upon, recite the entire verse and the reference. The first call will be a Practice Call.

(Note to Caller: When using more than one version, say: “Some of you are using different versions of the Bible. I will name the version and the portion of the verse for each version represented. If I call on you during the drill for the correct response, you may ask me to repeat the verse again.”)

Continue >>>>

Practice Call:

Attention.

KJV - What time I am afraid... (pause)

CSB - When I am afraid... (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee. Psalm 56:3

CSB – When I am afraid, I will trust in you. Psalm 56:3

Judges and Children, we now begin the Completion Drill.

1. Attention.

KJV – By this shall all men know... (pause)

CSB – By this everyone will know... (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – By this shall all *men* know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another. John 13:35

CSB – By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.” John 13:35

2. Attention.

KJV – For the Son of man... (pause)

CSB – For the Son of Man... (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost. Luke 19:10

CSB – For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save the lost.” Luke 19:10

Continue>>>>

3. Attention.

KJV – And this commandment have we from him ... (pause)

CSB – And we have this command from him:... (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

**KJV – And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.
1 John 4:21**

**CSB – And we have this command from him: The one who loves God must also love his brother and
sister. 1 John 4:21**

4. Attention.

KJV – Sing unto him, sing psalms... (pause)

CSB – Sing to him; sing praise... (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works. 1 Chronicles 16:9

CSB – Sing to him; sing praise to him; tell about all his wondrous works! 1 Chronicles 16:9

5. Attention.

KJV – And the people said unto Joshua,...” (pause)

CSB – So the people said to Joshua,...” (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

**KJV – And the people said unto Joshua, The LORD our God will we serve, and his voice will we
obey. Joshua 24:24**

**CSB – So the people said to Joshua, “We will worship the LORD our God and obey him.”
Joshua 24:24**

Continue>>>>

6. Attention.

KJV – Go ye therefore, and teach all nations,... (pause)

CSB – Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations,... (pause)

Start. (Call on child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen. Matthew 28:19-20

CSB – Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.” Matthew 28:19-20

We have now completed the Completion Drill.

<p>Optional Completion Drill</p> <p>Attention.</p> <p>KJV – Use hospitality... (pause)</p> <p>CSB – Be hospitable... (pause)</p> <p>Start. (Call on child after “time” has been called.)</p> <p>ANSWER:</p> <p>KJV – Use hospitality one to another without grudging. 1 Peter 4:9</p> <p>CSB – Be hospitable to one another without complaining. 1 Peter 4:9</p>

We are finished! Thank you, boys and girls, for doing such a wonderful job. Our judges will now leave to tally the results of our Drill. Parents, at this time it will be fine to take pictures. While our Judges are getting the results together, we will say the Books of the Bible. Number one, will you begin please?

(You may use this time in several ways. Testimonies by drillers of what Bible Drill means to them or sharing a fun time their Bible Drill has shared together are some possibilities as you wait for the Judges to return.)

After the return of the judges, pass out the Children's Bible Drill certificates. Then dismiss the drillers and prepare for the next drill.
