Blue Cycle

Welcome to _____(Church) Bible Drill. My name is _____. I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these students have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart.

Thank you, parents and church leaders, for encouraging and supporting your students. We know today is a special day for them and your family. Let me remind you that during the drill you may not be able to hear everything I say because my back will be to you. The students will be asked to keep their eyes on me. They may glance at you so be sure to keep a smile on your face to encourage them.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions by turning off cell phones, electronic games, and other devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

Turn towards the students.

Students, now I want to remind you:

- Keep your hands at your side until I say "attention."
- Your eyes are to stay on me until I say "start."
- Do not step out if you don't know the answer.
- Place your index finger on your Bible **before** stepping out.
- If you start forward when "time" is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you "beat the clock."
- If you step forward, don't go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand. When I acknowledge your hand, you may lower it but do not step back.
- Treat your Bible with respect.

Are there any questions?

Let's start with a word of prayer. (Pray.)

Continues>>>>

Our first section will be the “Book Call”. I will call the name of a book in the Bible. You will find the book, place your index finger on any verse in the book named and step forward. If I call your number, you will say the book *before* the one called, the book called, and the book that *follows*.

Judges and students, we now begin the Book Drill.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Ruth. (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Judges, RUTH, 1 Samuel

2. Attention.

Present Bibles.

James. (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Hebrews, JAMES, 1 Peter

3. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Luke (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Mark, LUKE, John

4. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Ecclesiastes (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Proverbs, ECCLESIASTES, Song of Solomon

5. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Ephesians. (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Galatians, EPHESIANS, Philippians

EXTRA CALL:

Attention.

Present Bibles.

Ezra. (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: 2 Chronicles, EZRA, Nehemiah

This ends the Book Drill.

We will now have the SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL. There will be 5 calls. I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse, and step forward. If called upon, you will read the verse and give the Scripture reference.

1. Attention

Present Bibles.

PHILIPPIANS 4:4 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

KJV – Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice. (Philippians 4:4)

CSB - Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! (Philippians 4:4)

2. Attention

Present Bibles.

Psalm 105:43 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

KJV - And he brought forth his people with joy, *and* his chosen with gladness. (Psalm 105:43)

CSB – He brought his people out with rejoicing, his chosen ones with shouts of joy. (Psalm 105:43)

3. Attention

Present Bibles.

JAMES 4:10 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

KJV— Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. (James 4:10)

CSB — Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you. (James 4:10)

Continues>>>>

4. Attention
Present Bibles.
JEREMIAH 29:13 *(pause)*
Start. *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

KJV – And ye shall seek me, and find *me*, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.
(Jeremiah 29:13)

CSB - You will seek me and find me when you search for me with all your heart. (Jeremiah 29:13)

5. Attention
Present Bibles.
MATTHEW 4:19 *(pause)*
Start. *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

KJV-- And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. (Matthew 4:19)

CSB -- “Follow me,” he told them, “and I will make you fish for people.” (Matthew 4:19)

EXTRA CALL:

- Attention
Present Bibles.
1 John 1:8 *(pause)*
Start. *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

KJV-- If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (1 John 1:8)

CSB – If we say, “We have no sin,” we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (1 John 1:8)

This ends the SCRIPTURE SEARCHING Drill.

We will now have the IDENTIFYING VERSES DRILL. There will be 5 calls. I will quote the underlined part of the Scripture verse. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse, and step forward. When called upon, read the entire verse and give the reference.

Continues>>>>

1. **Attention**

Present Bibles.

KJV – **for I am fearfully and wonderfully made:...** *(pause)*

CSB – **I have been remarkably and wondrously made...** *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV — I will praise thee; **for I am fearfully and wonderfully made:** marvelous *are* they works; and *that* my soul knoweth right well. Psalm 139:14

CSB — I will praise you because **I have been remarkably and wondrously made.** Your works are wondrous, and I know this very well. Psalm 139:14

2. **Attention.**

Present Bibles.

KJV – **Beware lest any man spoil you ...** *(pause)*

CSB – **Be careful that no one takes you captive...** *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV— **Beware lest any man spoil you** through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 2:8

CSB — **Be careful that no one takes you captive** through philosophy and empty deceit based on human tradition, based on the elements of the world, rather than Christ. Colossians 2:8

3. **Attention.**

Present Bibles.

KJV – **If any man will come after me ...** *(pause)*

CSB – **“If anyone wants to follow after me, ...** *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV— And he said to *them* all, **If any man will come after me,** let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. Luke 9:23

CSB — Then he said to them all, **“If anyone wants to follow after me,** let him deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow me. Luke 9:23

Continues>>>>

4. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV – **“which is, and which was, and which is to come ... (pause)**

CSB – **“the one who is, who was, and who is to come, ... (pause)**

Start. (Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV— I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, **“which is, and which was, and which is to come,** the Almighty. Revelation 1:8

CSB— “I am the Alpha and the Omega,” says the Lord God, **“the one who is, who was, and who is to come,** the Almighty.” Revelation 1:8

5. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV – **and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified ... (pause)**

CSB – **and to give you an inheritance among all who are sanctified.... (pause)**

Start. (Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV— And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, **and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.** Acts 20:32

CSB — “And now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up **and to give you an inheritance among all who are sanctified.** Acts 20:32

EXTRA CALL

Attention:

Present Bibles.

KJV – **For I know *that* my redeemer liveth, ... (pause)**

CSB – **But I know that my Redeemer lives, ... (pause)**

Start. (Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV— **For I know *that* my redeemer liveth,** and *that* he shall stand at the latter *day* upon the earth. Job 19:25

CSB — **But I know that my Redeemer lives,** and at the end he will stand on the dust. Job 19:25

This ends the Identifying Verses Drill.

We will now begin the DOCTRINAL DRILL. I will give you a doctrinal statement; you will locate the verse that corresponds with that doctrinal subject. Place you index finger on the verse, then step out. When called upon, you will state the doctrine, read the verse, and give the reference.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles

THE CHRISTIAN AND SOCIAL CONCERNS *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on student after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV— And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, Deuteronomy 10:12

CSB — “And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God ask of you except to fear the Lord your God by walking in all his ways, to love him, and to worship the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul? Deuteronomy 10:12

2. Attention

Present Bibles

LAST THINGS *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on student after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV— But of that day and hour knoweth no *man*, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only. Matthew 24:36

CSB — “Now concerning that day and hour no one knows – neither the angels of heaven nor the Son – except the Father alone. Matthew 24:36

Continues>>>>

3. Attention

Present Bibles

THE KINGDOM *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV— And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel. Mark 1:15

CSB— “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!” Mark 1:15

4. Attention

Present Bibles

STEWARDSHIP *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV— I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive. Acts 20:35

CSB— In every way I’ve shown you that it is necessary to help the weak by laboring like this and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, for he said, “It is more blessed to give than to receive.” Acts 20:35

5. Attention

Present Bibles

GRACE *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV— In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; Ephesians 1:7

CSB— In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace. Ephesians 1:7

Continues>>>>

EXTRA CALL

Attention.

Present Bibles

GOD *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after "time" has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV— For *there* is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
1 Timothy 2:5

CSB— For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus,
1 Timothy 2:5

This ends the Doctrinal Drill

We will now have the BIBLE ANSWERS DRILL. There will be 5 calls in this section. I will ask a question. You will locate the verse that answers the question, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. When called upon, please quote the question, recite the verse WORD FOR WORD, and state the reference.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN GOD’S PEOPLE PRAY? *(pause)*

Start. (Close your Bibles)

(Call on a student after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV— If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

CSB— and my people, who bear my name, humble themselves, pray and seek my face, and turn from their evil ways, then I will hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.
2 Chronicles 7:14

Continues>>>>

2. Attention.

Present Bibles

HOW CAN I BE SAVED? *(pause)*

Start. (Close your Bibles)

(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV— For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord will be saved. Romans 10:13

CSB— For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. Romans 10:13

3. Attention

Present Bibles

HOW CAN I FIGHT THE DEVIL? *(pause)*

Start. (Close your Bibles)

(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV-- Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*. Ephesians 6:11-12

CSB— Put on the full armor of God so that you can stand against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this darkness, against evil, spiritual forces in the heavens. Ephesians 6:11-12

Continues>>>>

4. Attention

Present Bibles

WHAT THINGS SHOULD I THINK ABOUT? *(pause)*

Start. (Close your Bibles)

(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV-- Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things *are* honest, whatsoever things *are* just, whatsoever things *are* pure, whatsoever things *are* lovely, whatsoever things *are* of good report, if *there be* any virtue, and if *there be* any praise, think on these things. Philippians 4:8

CSB— Finally brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable – if there is any moral excellence and if there is anything praiseworthy – dwell on these things. Philippians 4:8

5. Attention

Present Bibles

HOW LONG DOES GOD’S WORD LAST? *(pause)*

Start. (Close your Bibles)

(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV-- But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you. 1 Peter 1:25

CSB— but the word of the Lord endures forever. And this word is the gospel that was proclaimed to you. 1 Peter 1:25

EXTRA CALL

Attention

Present Bibles

WHAT IS FAITH? *(pause)*

Start. (Close your Bibles)

(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV-- Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1

CSB— Now faith is the reality of what is hoped for, the proof of what is not seen. Hebrews 11:1

Continues>>>>

We have now completed the Bible Answers Drill.

We are finished! Thank you, students for doing such a wonderful job. Our judges will now leave to tally the results of our Drill. Parents, at this time it will be fine to take pictures.
