## Practice Drill Two

### Blue Cycle

Welcome to \_\_\_\_\_(Church) Bible Drill. My name is \_\_\_\_\_. I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these students have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart.

Thank you, parents and church leaders, for encouraging and supporting your students. We know today is a special day for them and your family. Let me remind you that during the drill you may not be able to hear everything I say because my back will be to you. The students will be asked to keep their eyes on me. They may glance at you so be sure to keep a smile on your face to encourage them.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions by turning off cell phones, electronic games, and other devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

### ***Turn towards the students.***

Students, now I want to remind you:

- Keep your hands at your side until I say "attention."
- Your eyes are to stay on me until I say "start."
- Do not step out if you don't know the answer.
- Place your index finger on your Bible **before** stepping out.
- If you start forward when "time" is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you "beat the clock."
- If you step forward, don't go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand. When I acknowledge your hand, you may lower it but do not step back.
- Treat your Bible with respect.

Are there any questions?

Let's start with a word of prayer. (Pray.)

**Our first section will be the “Book Call”. I will call the name of a book in the Bible. You will find the book, place your index finger on any verse in the book named and step forward. If I call your number, you will say the book *before* the one called, the book called, and the book that *follows*.**

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Numbers, DEUTERONOMY, Joshua

**2. Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**2 TIMOTHY.** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** 1 Timothy, 2 TIMOTHY, Titus

**3. Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**GALATIANS** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** 2 Corinthians, GALATIANS, Ephesians

**4. Attention.**

**Present Bibles.**

**ZEPHANIAH** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Habakkuk, ZEPHANIAH, Haggai

**5. Attention.**

**ROMANS.** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:** Acts, ROMANS, 1 Corinthians

**Start.** (Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

**ANSWER:** 3 John, JUDE, Revelation

**We will now have the SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL. There will be 5 calls. I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse, and step forward. If called upon, you will read the verse and give the Scripture reference.**

1. Attention

**Present Bibles.**

**GENESIS 1:27** (pause)

**Start.** (Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

**KJV:** So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. Genesis 1:27

**CSB:** So God created man in his own image; he created him in the image of God; he created them male and female. Genesis 1:27

2. Attention

**Present Bibles.**

**JOHN 1:1** (pause)

**Start.** (Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

**KJV:** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:1

**CSB:** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:1

3. Attention  
**Present Bibles.**  
**PSALM 115:1** *(pause)*  
**Start.** *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*
- KJV:** Not unto us, O Lord, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for thy mercy, *and* for thy truth’s sake. Psalm 115:1
- CSB:** Not to us, LORD, not to us, but to your name give glory because of your faithful love, because of your truth. Psalm 115:1

4. Attention

**LAMENTATIONS 5:21** *(pause)*  
**Start.** *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*
- KJV:** Turn thou us unto thee, O LORD, and we shall be turned; renew our days as of old. Lamentations 5:21
- CSB:** LORD, bring us to yourself, so we may return; renew our days as in former times, Lamentations 5:21

5. Attention  
**Present Bibles.**  
**MATTHEW 28:6** *(pause)*  
**Start.** *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*
- KJV:** He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. Matthew 28:6
- CSB:** He is not here. For he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. Matthew 28:6

**EXTRA CALL:**

**JEREMIAH 29:13** *(pause)*  
**Start.** *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

- KJV:** And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart. Jeremiah 29:13
- CSB:** You will seek me and find me when you search for me with all your heart. Jeremiah 29:13

**This ends the SCRIPTURE SEARCHING Drill.**

We will now have the **IDENTIFYING VERSES DRILL**. There will be 5 calls. I will quote the underlined part of the Scripture verse. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse, and step forward. When called upon, read the entire verse and give the reference.

**1. Attention**  
**Present Bibles.**

**KJV – If any man will come after me,...** *(pause)*

**CSB – “If anyone wants to follow after me,...** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV:** And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. Luke 9:23

**CSB** Then he said to them all, “If anyone wants to follow after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow me.” Luke 9:23

**2. Attention.**  
**Present Bibles.**

**KJV – and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. ...** *(pause)*

**CSB – and that he rewards those who seek him...** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**KJV:** But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. Hebrews 11:6

**CSB:** Now without faith it is impossible to please God, since the one who draws near to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him. Hebrews 11:6

Present Bibles.

KJV – For the wages of sin is death; ... (pause)

CSB – For the wages of sin is death, ... (pause)

Start. (Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV— For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.  
Romans 6:23

CSB — For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.  
Romans 6:23

4. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV – that ye stand fast in one spirit, ... (pause)

CSB – that you are standing firm in one spirit,... (pause)

Start. (Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV: Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; Philippians 1:27

CSB Just one thing: As citizens of heaven, live your life worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or am absent, I will hear about you that you are standing firm in one spirit, in one accord, contending together for the faith of the gospel, Philippians 1:27

5. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV – they shall mount up with wings as eagles; ... (pause)

CSB – they will soar on wings like eagles, ... (pause)

Start. (Call on a student after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV— But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint.  
(Isaiah 40:31)

CSB — but those who trust in the LORD will renew their strength; they will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not become weary, they will walk and not faint. Isaiah 40:31

**Attention:**

**Present Bibles.**

**KJV – which is, and which was, and which is to come, ... (pause)**

**CSB – “the one who is, who was, and who is to come,.... (pause)**

**Start.** *(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV:** I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty. Revelation 1:8

**CSB** “I am the Alpha and the Omega,” says the Lord God, “the one who is, who was, and who is to come, the Almighty.” Revelation 1:8

**This ends the Identifying Verses Drill.**

**We will**

**now begin the DOCTRINAL DRILL. There will be 5 calls in this section. I will give you a doctrinal statement; you will locate the verse that corresponds with that doctrinal subject. Place you index finger on the verse, then step out. When called upon, you will state the doctrine, read the verse, and give the reference. You may state these in the order most comfortable for you.**

**1. Attention.**

**Present Bibles**

**THE LORD’S DAY (pause)**

**Start.** *(Call on student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.  
Colossians 3:16

**CSB** Let the word of Christ dwell richly among you, in all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another through psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.  
Colossians 3:16

**2. Attention**

**Present Bibles**

**GOD** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV—** For *there* is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;  
1 Timothy 2:5

**CSB—** For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus,  
1 Timothy 2:5

**3. Attention**

**Present Bibles**

**COOPERATION** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV:** That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. (John 17:21)

**CSB:** May they all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us, so that the world may believe you sent me. (John 17:21)

**4. Attention**

**Present Bibles**

**EDUCATION** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV:** Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths. Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day. (Psalm 25:4-5)

**CSB:** Make your ways known to me, LORD; teach me your paths. Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; I wait for you all day long. (Psalm 25:4-5)

**THE LORD’S DAY** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.  
Colossians 3:16

**CSB** Let the word of Christ dwell richly among you, in all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another through psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

**THE CHRISTIAN AND SOCIAL CONCERNS** *(pause)*

**Start.** *(Call on student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV**— And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,  
Deuteronomy 10:12

**CSB** — “And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God ask of you except to fear the Lord your God by walking in all his ways, to love him, and to worship the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul?  
Deuteronomy 10:12

**This ends the Doctrinal Drill**

**We will now have the BIBLE ANSWERS DRILL. There will be 5 calls in this section. I will ask a question. You will locate the verse that answers the question, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. When called upon, please quote the question, recite the verse WORD FOR WORD, and state the reference.**

**Continues>>>>**

**1. Attention.**

**Present Bibles**

**WHAT DOES GOD SAY ABOUT HOLINESS?** *(pause)*

**Start. (Close your Bibles)**

*(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV** And ye shall be holy unto me: for I the LORD am holy, and have severed you from other people, that ye should be mine. (Leviticus 20:26)

**CSB:** You are to be holy to me because I, the LORD, am holy, and I have set you apart from the nations to be mine. (Leviticus 20:26)

**2. Attention.**

**Present Bibles**

**WHAT IS FAITH?** *(pause)*

**Start. (Close your Bibles)**

*(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV--** Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1

**CSB—** Now faith is the reality of what is hoped for, the proof of what is not seen. Hebrews 11:1

**3. Attention**

**Present Bibles**

**HOW SHOULD I TREAT OTHERS?** *(pause)*

**Start. (Close your Bibles)**

*(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV:** And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me. Matthew 25:40

**CSB** “And the King will answer them, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.’ Matthew 25:40

**4. Attention**

**Present Bibles**

**WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT ALCOHOL?** *(pause)*

**Start. (Close your Bibles)**

*(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV:** Wine *is* a mocker, strong drink *is* raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise. Proverbs 20:1

**CSB:** Wine is a mocker, beer is a brawler; whoever goes astray because of them is not wise. Proverbs 20:1

**5. Attention**

**Present Bibles**

**WHAT CAN I LEARN FROM DIFFICULTIES?** *(pause)*

**Start. (Close your Bibles)**

*(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV:** And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. 2 Corinthians 12:9

**CSB:** But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is perfected in weakness.” Therefore, I will most gladly boast all the more about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may reside in me. 2 Corinthians 12:9

**EXTRA CALL**

**Attention**

**Present Bibles**

**HOW LONG DOES GOD’S WORD LAST?** *(pause)*

**Start. (Close your Bibles)**

*(Call on a student after “time” has been called.)*

**ANSWER:**

**KJV:** But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you. 1 Peter 1:25

**CSB:** but the word of the Lord endures forever. And this word is the gospel that was proclaimed to you. 1 Peter 1:25

**We have now completed the Bible Answers Drill.**
