

Session Twenty-Two: Bible Verse Review



Today's Bible Skill:

- Review Bible Verses
 - Joshua 24:24 (Week 6)
 - Psalm 56:3 (Week 9)
 - Luke 2:52 (Week 16)
 - John 13:35 (Week 18)

Divide Group into 4 Teams – Each team will rotate through Bible Verse Review stations.

Bible Verse Activity: Hot Potato – Joshua 24:24 - Week 6

Materials:

Foam Ball Bible – one for each group (no more than 6-8 kids)

Cardstock

Thin tip markers or Crayons

Prepare:

Print Joshua 24:24 on cardstock – one for each group.

Instructions:

Invite kids to form circles of no more than 6-8 kids and sit facing each other.

Choose one member of the group to sit in the middle of the circle. Give another member of the group a foam ball. Explain that the kid in the center will be listening to be sure Joshua 24:24 is said correctly. The kids with the ball will toss it to another member of the group saying one word of the verse (in order) as the ball is passed. Whoever is holding the ball on the last word is “out” and will change places with the person sitting in the middle of the circle. Repeat the game for 2-3 rounds.

Bible Verse Activity: Apply the Verse – Psalm 56:3 – Week 9

Materials:

Poster board

Strips of paper

Markers

Tape

Prepare:

Write first part of Psalm 56:3 – When I am afraid (CSB) or What time I am afraid (KJV) on top of poster board.

Leave middle of poster blank

Write last part of Psalm 56:3 – I will trust in you. (CSB) or I will trust in thee. (KJV) on bottom part of poster board.

Instructions:

Invite kids to write a time when they made be afraid on a strip of paper (ex: during a storm, when I am alone, in the dark, when I am sick) and place it a basket [allows anonymity]

Have kids form a circle. Ask kids to read the Bible verse together – adding a statement from the basket.

When I am afraid – when I am alone – I will trust in you. (CSB). What time I am afraid – during a storm – I will trust in thee. (KJV) Psalm 56:3. Continue until all strips have been shared. End by saying the verse together.

Bible Verse Activity: Follow the Leader – Luke 2:52 - Week 16**Materials:**

Posterboard

Paper strips

Prepare:

Write out Luke 2:52 on posterboard

Place poster where visible for kids

Write actions on paper strips.

Suggestions:

- Jumping Jacks
- Walking like a penguin
- Stand, sit, stand, sit (repeat pattern until verse is completed)
- March in a circle
- Standing on one foot
- Two steps forward, two steps backward (repeat pattern until verse is completed)
- Flapping arms like a bird
- Standing tall like a bear

Paper lunch bag

Instructions:

Choose a “leader” from the group. Instruct leader to draw a piece of paper from the bag and lead the group in reciting Luke 2:52 in the way indicated on the paper.

Choose another “leader”. Continue as time allows.

Bible Verse Activity: Concentration – John 13:35 - Week 18

Materials:

Index Cards – a different color for each group of 4-6 kids, if possible. [16 (CSB)/19 (KJV) per group]

Pen

Red poster board

Marker

Prepare:

Cut out a large heart from the red poster board and write John 13:35 on it.

Write each word from John 13:35 on a separate index card – two sets per group. Mix 2 sets of cards up (same color).

CSB: By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.” John 13:35

KJV: By this shall all *men* know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another. John 13:35

Tape red heart with verse where it is visible for all the kids to see.

Instructions:

Divide kids into teams of no more than 6 kids.

Give each team their stack of 2 sets of index cards. Have them place cards on the floor face down (concentration).

The team with the birthday closest to that day will begin. The player chooses a card and tries to find the match, if he finds it, he continues until he does not find the correct word. If he does not make a match, the card is returned to its spot. The team member sitting to the right of the first player will take his turn. Continue taking turns until all matches have been found. Once all matches have been found, the teams will line up words in correct order and recite John 13:35 together.
