

# T B M B 2 0 2 5 M A Y P R A Y E R G U I D E

Prayer prompts for TBMB ministries and other ministries are supported by gifts from Tennessee Baptists through the Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions and Cooperative Program.

**1 Next Gen Worship:** Pray for Daniel Doss and Wayne Causey as they lead the Next Gen Worship Project tonight. This training helps teach and explore opportunities to serve the church through media, tech, worship, instruments, and song writing.

**2 Evangelism Training:** Pray for Spanish-speaking pastors meeting at Iglesia Bautista Gracia Y Verdad in Morristown for evangelism training in Gospel conversations.

**3 Mental Health:** Pray for Mental Health First Aid for Adults happening at Columbia Hill Baptist Church. This workshop teaches recognition of mental health challenges and providing appropriate help.

**4 Associational Ministries:** Pray for the eight associations seeking new leaders. Ask God to equip each association for their mission work as they serve as ground zero for winning Tennessee for Jesus.

**5 Collegiate Ministries:** Pray for the May 5th Appreciation Luncheon honoring those who have served UTK BCM this year, including volunteers for Soul Food, TNT speakers, building repair volunteers, Board members, van drivers, and donors.

**6 Foster Care:** During Foster Care Awareness Month, ask God to call Tennessee Baptists to foster and impact the lives of children without homes.

**7 Collegiate Ministries:** Pray for the team of 10 Cleveland and UTC BCM students heading to Portland, OR on a Mission Trip May 17-24. Ask for boldness and protection as they serve and share the Good News.

**8 Church Planting:** Pray for the West Tennessee training cohort in Collierville. Five church planters are learning principles of planting healthy, reproducing churches.

**9 Pregnancy Resource Centers:** Pray for centers across the state providing help and hope for women experiencing unplanned pregnancies. Ask for wisdom and grace for the volunteers serving in this ministry.

**10 Church Planting:** Pray for Redeemer City Church launching in May in Knoxville. Pray for Pastor Trent Roseman who will lead this congregation.

**11 Associational Ministry:** Pray for associations preparing for VBS clinics. Ask God to lay the groundwork for an incredible summer of Vacation Bible School.

**12 Disaster Relief:** Pray that the over 2,000 Tennesseans who received Disaster Relief training in the last 6 months will use their skills to serve neighbors, churches, communities, and to share Christ.

**13 Collegiate Ministries:** Pray for UTK BCM summer missionaries in training and heading to mission assignments with churches, Christian camps, BCMs SendTN, IMB, and NAMB.

**14 BlueOval City:** Pray for construction workers at Blue Oval City as volunteers engage them. Ask for Gospel conversation opportunities and lasting impact from new church plants in the area.

**15 Mental Health Event:** Pray for the Youth Mental Health First Aid conference on May 17th, training adults who work with youth ages 12-18 in mental health awareness and response strategies.

**16 All Nations Camp:** Pray for All Nations Camp happening in June. Ask God to send students and volunteers to support this life-changing experience.

**17 Day of Prayer for VBS:** Today is the statewide emphasis encouraging churches to pray for Vacation Bible School and Backyard Kids Clubs.

**18 Collegiate Ministries:** Pray for 39 summer missionaries serving in Tennessee and worldwide through Send TN. Ask for Holy Spirit guidance, team unity, and Gospel-sharing opportunities.

**19 Generosity:** Pray for churches that have never given through the Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions. Ask for increased giving to meet post-pandemic ministry needs.

**20 Church Planting:** Pray for a new church replant starting in May in Maryville. Pray for Broadway Baptist's leadership as they launch this replant in the Rockford area.

**21 Tornado Recovery:** Pray for Disaster Relief volunteers helping Selmer residents rebuild after last month's tornadoes. Pray for First Baptist Church Selmer as they serve their community.

**22 Baptist Associations:** Pray for pastorless churches in Tennessee and for Associational Mission Strategists ministering to these congregations during pastoral searches.

**23 Prayer Ministry:** Pray for Nancy Duggin, Prayer Catalyst for Tennessee Baptists. Ask for wisdom and creativity as she leads this vital prayer initiative.

**24 YEC Follow-up:** Pray for the discipleship of over 250 students who made decisions for Christ during Youth Evangelism Conferences. Ask for boldness in baptism and sharing God's grace.

**25 Compassion Ministries:** Pray for Beth Moore, TBMB's Compassion Ministries Specialist, as she organizes compassion work throughout the state. Ask for wisdom in stewarding resources.

**26 TBMB Leadership:** Pray for Dr. Randy C. Davis, asking for continued strength, health and opportunity as he travels Tennessee, leads the TBMB staff, and ministers to pastors.

**27 Minister Wellness:** Pray for Joe Sorah as he encourages and coaches pastors statewide, creating solutions to help pastors and leaders live passionate, healthy lives.

**28 Church Planting:** Pray for church multiplication collaboration meetings in Jackson and Knoxville. Ask God to raise up volunteers to assist in planting Gospel-sharing churches.

**29 Refugee Missions:** Pray for ministries serving refugees in Tennessee. Ask God to raise up churches and believers to welcome those He sends to our state.

**30 Evangelism & Discipleship:** Pray for Tennessee Baptists to pray, connect, invite, share, love, grow, and multiply to win Tennessee for Christ, seeing themselves as missionaries on a mission field.

**31 Disaster Relief:** Pray for Arise and Build teams continuing to rebuild homes destroyed by Hurricane Helene. Ask that they will serve and share Christ's love effectively.
