Session Ten: God's Word Shows Us the Way

Today's Point:

God's Word helps us make the right choices.

Bible Verse: Psalm 119:105

CSB: Your word is a lamp for my feet and a light on my path. **KJV:** Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

Today's Bible Skill:

- Memorize Psalm 119:105
- Know that Psalms is in the middle of the Bible
- Learn that Psalm 119 talks about how amazing God's Word is

Bible Truth Activity:

Game: "Step-by-Step"

Object of the game: Kids will understand how God's Word helps them take the next right step.

Materials:

- Masking tape to make a winding path on the floor
- Index cards with simple "right choice" or "wrong choice" scenarios (e.g., "Your friend drops her pencil. Do you help her?")

Directions:

- 1. Place the "step path" on the floor.
- 2. Have one child stand at the start. Read a card aloud.
- 3. If the answer is a right choice, they take one step forward. If it's a wrong choice, they stay still.
- 4. Continue until they reach the end of the path.

Say:

Every day, we make choices. Sometimes we don't know what to do, but when we read the Bible, it's like turning on a light to show the right path!

Bible Discovery Discussion:

Ask the kids:

- What does a light do when it's dark?
- What might happen if you walk in the dark without a light?
- Why is it important that God's Word is a "lamp for our feet"?

Say:

The world is full of decisions—what we say, how we treat people, what we believe. Psalm 119:105 says God's Word helps us find the right way. If we read the Bible, we'll learn how to be kind, truthful, brave, and obedient.

Bible Verse Activity - Word Build Relay

Materials:

- Word cards for each part of Psalm 119:105 (1 word per card)
- Basket or bucket to hold them

Instructions:

- 1. Divide kids into 2–3 teams.
- 2. On "Go," the first child from each team races to grab one word from the basket and brings it back.
- 3. Keep going until all words are collected.
- 4. Work as a team to put the words in the correct order to build Psalm 119:105.
- 5. Read it together as a group.

Say:

That was fun! God's Word is made up of lots of important words, and every one of them helps us walk with Him.

Bible Skills Activity: "Shine a Light" Scavenger Hunt

Materials:

- Flashlight
- Bible
- Slips of paper with short Bible verses or "light" clues hidden around the room

Instructions:

- 1. Turn the lights low or off if safe.
- 2. Kids take turns using the flashlight to search for the hidden clues.
- 3. When someone finds Psalm 119:105, have everyone stop and read it together.

Say:

Just like a flashlight helps you see in the dark, God's Word helps you see the right way to live. Don't walk through life without your light—read your Bible and follow what it says!
