

Session Two: God Created Everything



Today's Point:

God made the world, and He made everything in it.

Bible Verse: Genesis 1:1

CSB: In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

KJV: In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Today's Bible Skill:

- Begin to memorize Genesis 1:1
- Know that Genesis is the first book of the Bible and the first book of the Old Testament.
- Begin to learn the first five books of the Old Testament.

Bible Truth Activity:

Game: Creation Clap & Stomp

Object of the game: Kids will act out the days of creation with sound and movement.

Directions:

1. Say a day of creation (Day 1, Day 2, etc.) and what God created on that day.
2. The kids will clap once if it's something God made in the sky.
Stomp once if it's something God made on the ground.
Clap and stomp together if it's something that fills the earth or sky (like animals or people).
3. Example:
 - "Day 1 – Light!" (Clap)
 - "Day 3 – Plants!" (Stomp)
 - "Day 5 – Birds and fish!" (Clap and stomp)
4. Continue through the 6 days of creation.

After the game, say:

God made everything! He made light, land, animals, the sky, people—everything! The Bible tells us, "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." (Genesis 1:1). That means God was there before everything else, and He made it all!

Bible Discovery Discussion:

Ask the kids:

- Who made the world? (God!)
- What did God make? (Everything!)
- What does the first verse in the Bible say? (“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”)
- Why do you think it’s important that God made everything?

Say:

God is so powerful and good! When we look at the stars, the trees, the animals, and even ourselves—we remember that God made it all. That means we can trust Him because He knows everything about us and the world He made.

Bible Verse Activity – Song and Movement

Say: Genesis is the very first book in the Bible. Let's find it together. (Help kids turn to Genesis 1:1.)

Now let’s learn our memory verse with motions and a song.
(Sing to the tune of “Are You Sleeping?”)



In the beginning, in the beginning
God made the earth, God made the earth
And the heavens too, and the heavens too
Genesis 1:1, Genesis 1:1



Repeat several times, having kids sing and do motions (point up for “heavens,” spread arms wide for “earth”).

Bible Skills Activity: First 5 Books Race

Materials:

- Cards with the names of the first five books of the Bible: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy
- Bibles for each group (if available)

Instructions:

1. Divide kids into teams of 3–4.
2. Mix up the cards and lay them face down.
3. On “Go!” teams race to put the books in the correct order.
4. Once they have the order correct, help them say the books out loud:
“Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy.”

Say:

These are the first five books of the Bible. Genesis is the first, and it tells us how God made the world!
