

## It's Bible Drill Time in Tennessee!! Tips for Starting Children's Bible Drill

As you begin this season of Bible Drill here are a few tips to keep in mind.

- Tip 1: Enlist at least two (2) leaders over the age of 18 to serve each week in Children's Bible Drill.
- Tip 2: Set date, time, and location for weekly Bible Drill meetings. Be sure to check your church calendar for any conflict
- Tip 3: Plan a kickoff event. Invite 4th 6th graders, along with their parents, to a fun event that introduces them to Bible Drill. During this event include Bible Skill games and activities that encourages children and their parents to participate. You may consider inviting Children's Bible Drill alumni to come and present a demonstration drill.
